Tennis BC U9 & U10 Team Tennis @ 2018 Future Stars Year End Party is hosted by North Vancouver Tennis Centre. It is organized and run by Tennis BC.

No Leader Board points will be awarded.

Team Tennis Events:

U9, Boys U10, Girls U10

Maximum participants Under 9 – 32 Girls U10 – 16 Boys U10 – 32

Individual registration only. Acceptance will be first come, first served. Event may be cancelled or modified depending on the number of entries in each age group.

Entry fee: \$40 per player

Event schedule:

- U9 9:00 am to 3:00 pm
- Girls U10 11:00 am to 4:00 pm
- Boys U10 1:00 pm to 8:00 pm

The schedule is approximate and will be confirmed when teams are finalized.

Teams, Team ties, and draw format:

- Players will be placed in a team of 4 players according to the strength. Each team is composed of different level of players to ensure competition against the opposing team.
- Round robins and playoffs for each position for U9 and Boys U10. Girls U10 will be round robin of 4 teams. 3 match tie per team guarantee.
- Each team tie consists of 2 Singles and 1 Doubles. All 4 players of a team will play on 3 courts at the same time.

Match format:

- 25-min timed match or a pro-set (8 games) with NO-AD scoring whichever comes first. 5-point set tie break will be played at 7-7 games all (first to 5 points winning by a margin of 2). Modified match format may be adopted contingent on court availability.
- When time is up, and match is not complete, the following format will be used to decide the score of the match:
 - i) Player who leads the game wins the game.
 - ii) The game is not counted if it is a tie in the points of the game.
 - iii) When it is a tie in the game score, the match result will be recorded as it is.

Team Score

- One point will be given to each game won in all the matches. The team score is the total points all team members get.
- The winning team of the round robin and playoffs will be determined by the highest number of points.
- Ties in the results will be broken as follows:
 - i) If 2 teams are tied in the points, the tie will be broken by the head to head match result of the 2 teams.
 - ii) If 3 teams are tied with the same number of points, the tie is broken as follows:
 - The difference of the games won and the games lost.
 - If, after this calculation, only 2 teams remained tied, the head to head match result of the 2 teams.

Coaching

No coaches will be assigned, and no coaching is allowed.

On court monitor – parent volunteers

One parent of each team is required to be on court. The role is to assist scoring but only when requested. Parents will not assist the matches of their own child.

On court and off court guidelines

• No coaching is allowed. Do not communicate, visually or verbally while your child is playing a match.

- No outside officiating is allowed. Players are responsible for their own line calls. Do not call line for the player and do not make comment about any line calls.
- All movement should be minimized in order not to disrupt the match. Parents should leave the court only when the match is complete (about 30 min.)
