

2015 Individual Membership Benefits *TENNIS BC*

Membership with Tennis BC is required for participation in provincial and national **sanctioned (ranking)** events as well as Tennis BC supported **leagues**. Membership is valid for 12 months.

- **Tournament Support** - Tennis BC, in partnership with Tennis Canada, introduced a new membership, tournament registration and management system, and national/provincial rankings tool. The tournament planner is available to Member Clubs.
- **Website** – Tennis BC, in partnership with Tennis Canada launched a new website platform including information on tournaments and clubs, new stories, online registration and program offerings with partners of Tennis BC - www.tennisbc.org
- **Events** – Tennis BC coordinates and publishes a full calendar of sanctioned and non-sanctioned tennis tournaments for players of all ages and abilities, including the Stanley Park Open, Summer Series, Senior Series, Junior and Senior Provincial Championships, Future Stars Tour (U9, U10 kids tennis), Rogers Rookie Tour (novice U8-U16 tennis) and Miele Team Tennis for both Junior and Senior players.
- **Inter-Club Leagues** – Miele supports leagues and team tennis, with more than 30 divisions in the province, plus an annual Championships for adult and junior teams.
- **Rogers Rankings** – Tennis BC maintains rankings for junior, adult and senior categories.
- **Coaching Certification** – Tennis BC delivers Tennis Canada’s Coaching Certification, a comprehensive program that integrates coaching theory with specific technical information. The bi-annual Coaching Conference and regular certification clinics keep our coaches and instructors up-to-date.
- **Officiating Certification** – Tennis BC offers officiating courses for those interested in becoming certified Referees, Roving Umpires, Chair Umpires and Line Umpires under the Tennis Canada Officiating Program.
- **Rule School** – This 2-hour session is offered to clubs and league teams to encourage fair play and brush up on rules and etiquette that are pivotal to the enjoyment of the game.
- **E-News** is sent to Junior and Adult Members on a regular basis including upcoming events from Tennis Canada, Tennis BC and member clubs, special offers from friends of Tennis BC, local stories, BC player highlights, coaching tips and international/professional updates.
