The Centre is a North Vancouver Recreation & Culture Commission facility.

From its opening October 1999 to 2014, it was named Grant Connell Tennis Centre after Canadian born tennis star, Grant Connell. Who was the first Canadian ever to reach a doubles ranking of #1.

In 2014 the centre went through an expansion to add an additional 3 indoor courts with upper and lower viewing areas and one of Canada's first indoor 'Red' courts (scaled court for 6-8 year olds).

It was also re-named the North Vancouver Tennis Centre and now includes 9 indoor championship courts in permanent buildings with glassed viewing areas, seating areas, and change/shower facilities. It is the premiere public Tennis Centre in BC.

Full payment must be made at the time of registration. Entry fees are non-refundable once teams are placed in the draw.

Play:

 All matches will be 2 regular sets with a 'Super Tie-breaker' (First to 10 points) played if sets are tied 1-1. (The 'Super Tie-breaker' will count as the third set).

Scheduling:

- Players must be available to play at all times. Players more than 30 minutes late may be defaulted. If the draw is full, players will be required to compete every day (not possible to skip a day).
- Play begins Monday September 5 with play starting at 6:30pm.
 Finals will be Friday, September 9. Times may be adjusted according to number of entries.

Substitutions: (For injury or sickness)

• If the partner you started the event with gets sick or injured and is unable to play, you **may** get a replacement. This will ensure you can continue to play and not take away a match from any opponents either. However, teams with a substitute will not advance to the next winning round regardless of the score in their match. They will be placed in one of the secondary draws.

How the "Compass Draw" tournament works:

- Players from 3.0 to 4.5 level are welcome.
- All players are placed in the same draw to start
- Top rated teams are seeded throughout the draw.
- Teams that win continue in the main draw. Teams that lose move to secondary draws. **Each team gets 3-4 matches guaranteed!**
- The tournament has 8 separate 'draws' that can be won.
