POLICY STATEMENT

Tennis BC prohibits the use of performance enhancing drugs by any Employee, contractor, Board of Director, athlete, coach or volunteer of Tennis BC while participating in the business of the organization.

APPLICATION

The Government of British Columbia is committed to eliminating doping in B.C., Canada and around the world. The Sport Medicine Council of B.C. has put in place an unannounced Doping Control Program whereby every athlete who is in direct or indirect receipt of provincial sport benefits is required to complete an Authorization and Consent Form to participate in the Anti Doping Program and is subject to being randomly selected for testing. Are we now administering this?

PROCEDURES

- 1. All individuals affiliated with Tennis BC shall comply with provincial, national and/or international regulations on doping and shall submit themselves to random drug testing as required or requested.
- 2. Any individual affiliated with Tennis BC who is found to have committed doping infractions is subject to severe sport eligibility and government funding penalties.
- 3. Any individual affiliated with Tennis BC who is found to have committed doping infractions while conducing work on behalf of the organization is subject to immediate dismissal.
