RANKING POINTS	Rogers ranking points may be earned for the Main draw only. Ranking points will not be awarded for the Qualifying tournament.
ACCEPTANCE LISTS	Acceptance lists will be forwarded to the Provincial Associations and posted on the Tennis Canada web site on August 3. The top 32 ranked boys & girls entered based on the U16 and U18 Rogers rankings as of August 1 will be accepted into the Qualifying event. The top 32 boys and girls will be determined based on the following:
	1. Players in the Top 20 U18 2. Players in the Top 10 U16 3. Players ranked 21 and higher U18 Players not accepted into the Qualifying tournament will be placed in an order of priority based on the Rogers rankings as per the above criteria. Withdrawals from the Qualifying tournament will be replaced with players from this list.
SIGN-IN & DRAW	Sign-in: August 9, 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. at the club. Players on the Acceptance List must sign-in with the Referee on site at the Ontario Racquet Club. Players must show their passport at sign-in to verify their Canadian citizenship or Permanent Residency. Draw: The draw will be conducted immediately following the close of the sign-in. Withdrawals from the Qualifying tournament will be replaced by players from the Alternate list who have signed in.
FORMAT & SCHEDULE	4 boys and 4 girls will qualify for the Main Draw August 12-17 Two singles matches will be played on August 10, followed by the final round on August 11 to determine the qualifiers.
