- Help organize and structure the junior high performance program including setting up lesson plans, organizing team building events, and tournament trips in and out of town.
- Must have the ability to be upbeat and energetic throughout each lesson.
- Provide a friendly approach and be knowledgeable about both the Junior Tennis Program and the Adult Tennis Program and help provide a welcoming environment to each student.
- Adhere to all club/court rules and regulations. Be a good example.
- Collect, manage, and return all club equipment in good working condition.
- Ensure that the students are engaged in the lessons/activities at all times and that each student feels successful at every session.
- Share your passion for the game of tennis. Make your students smile!
- Other duties as assigned and agreed upon with the Tennis Director.
