REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

Please follow the 3-step registration process outlined in the Tennis BC [calendar posting](#). Players must register for selected events via the ITF website and then pay for selected events via the PayPal Button. Players that have not paid for selected events will NOT be included in the draw. Additionally, it is mandatory to purchase a Tennis BC membership in order to compete in this event.

SECOND DOUBLES EVENT ENTRY

The ITF website still does not permit players to register for two doubles events. As a result, we must submit entries to the ITF manually via email. If you wish to register for a second doubles event, please email Max (mkorkh@tennisbc.org) with your IPIN #, your full name as it appears on the ITF website and the event you wish to enter. Please make sure to make payment via the [calendar posting](#) promptly after submitting teams via email.

BANQUET

The annual banquet will take place on May 28th at 6pm at Jericho. Banquet tickets are included in the entry fee for all events, however, plus one tickets must be purchased via this link. CLUB POLICIES

Jericho's Board of Directors has reinforced its all-white attire rule during the outdoor season. Please wear non-marking shoes and no more than 20% coloured clothing during your matches. SCHEDULING & AVOIDANCES

Please take a moment to read through the information below as it contains important details regarding your entry to the tournament. Please email Tournament Ref Ika (ikaref@gmail.com) for scheduling inquires and avoidance requests.

1. Play may start as early as 8 am on Saturdays and Sundays and will start at 1:30 pm on weekdays.
2. No avoidance is allowed for the first weekend (May 27-28).
3. This tournament runs on weekdays and players may need to be available during working hours. Avoidance requests will not be accepted for play in evenings only.
4. Whenever possible on weekdays the schedule will play the matches of 65 and over categories first and followed by other age groups.
5. If you only enter 1 doubles event with total entries of 8 or less, an avoidance for the first weekend (May 27-28) may be accepted; contact tournament director/supervisor to confirm.
6. Note that this is an outdoor tournament and subject to weather disruption. In the event of rain, please check the website for updates before calling about your match.

A link will be posted on the Tennis BC [calendar posting](#) at the beginning of the tournament.

7. Consolation: Players will be required to sign in after their first match if they wish to play consolation. A decision on whether or not it is feasible to run consolation will be made once final tournament entry numbers are known. More details regarding consolation will be provided at a later date.
8. Player attire: Jericho Tennis Club has an all-white attire policy. Please be sure you have proper white tennis attire.
