Use this checklist to prepare for the upcoming season of Orange-Green Ball (U9/U10) Circuit tournaments. Please make sure you complete all actions for Pre-Tournament, Tournament Day and Wrap-Up.

Read the Circuit information provided on provincial website, study rules of the game and scoring. Check for additional information on the Provincial Websites' tournaments section. Identify the age-category and tournaments that you can participate in. Make sure the player is a registered competitor of the provincial tennis association and has paid the annual membership fee. Register for the selected tournament online (no more than one tournament at the same date), and receive or check the website for the confirmation of a place in the draw or a place on the waiting list. Check Tournament website for start times prior to your event. The start times will be posted with the event draw on the tournament software site (tc.tournamentsoftware.com). Check provincial website for information on acceptable player equipment and gear at U9/U10 Circuit Tournaments (not applicable to QC).	Arrive on time at tournament venue. Be prepared to play 15 minutes before the start time of your first game. Register at the tournament desk, pay the tournament fee if applicable and check your schedule of play. After finishing your match, report your score to the tournament desk. Parents should remember to abstain from officiating games (calling lines, score). In the absence of a court monitor, parents may be asked to volunteer. (Parents will not monitor matches of their own children). Parents should remember to abstain from coaching. Phrases like "move your feet, remember what we talked about", etc. are considered coaching and players can be penalized. For parents: clapping is encouraged, but should not be on opponent's mistakes and double faults.	Check the Tournament website (https://tc.tournament software.com/) for tournament results and scores. Check your leaderboard position on the PTA website (leaderboard will be updated on the Wednesday after each tournament).
