Tennis BC is looking for a dependable Hub Night-time Security to patrol the facility, including indoor courts, lounge areas, locker rooms, offices, and parking areas. A professional presence is essential to help maintain a safe environment and deter theft or vandalism.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

- Patrol 4 indoor tennis courts, player lounge, locker rooms, offices, and parking areas
- Monitor surveillance systems and alarm panels
- Enforce member access rules and verify after-hours entry
- Monitoring court bookings during their shift
- Respond to disturbances, safety concerns, or medical issues
- Lock facilities as scheduled after shift
- Document incidents and communicate with management
- Provide a visible security presence to deter theft and vandalism

- Prior security experience preferred
- Ability to stay alert during overnight hours
- Good communication and conflict-resolution skills
- Basic CPR/First Aid a plus
